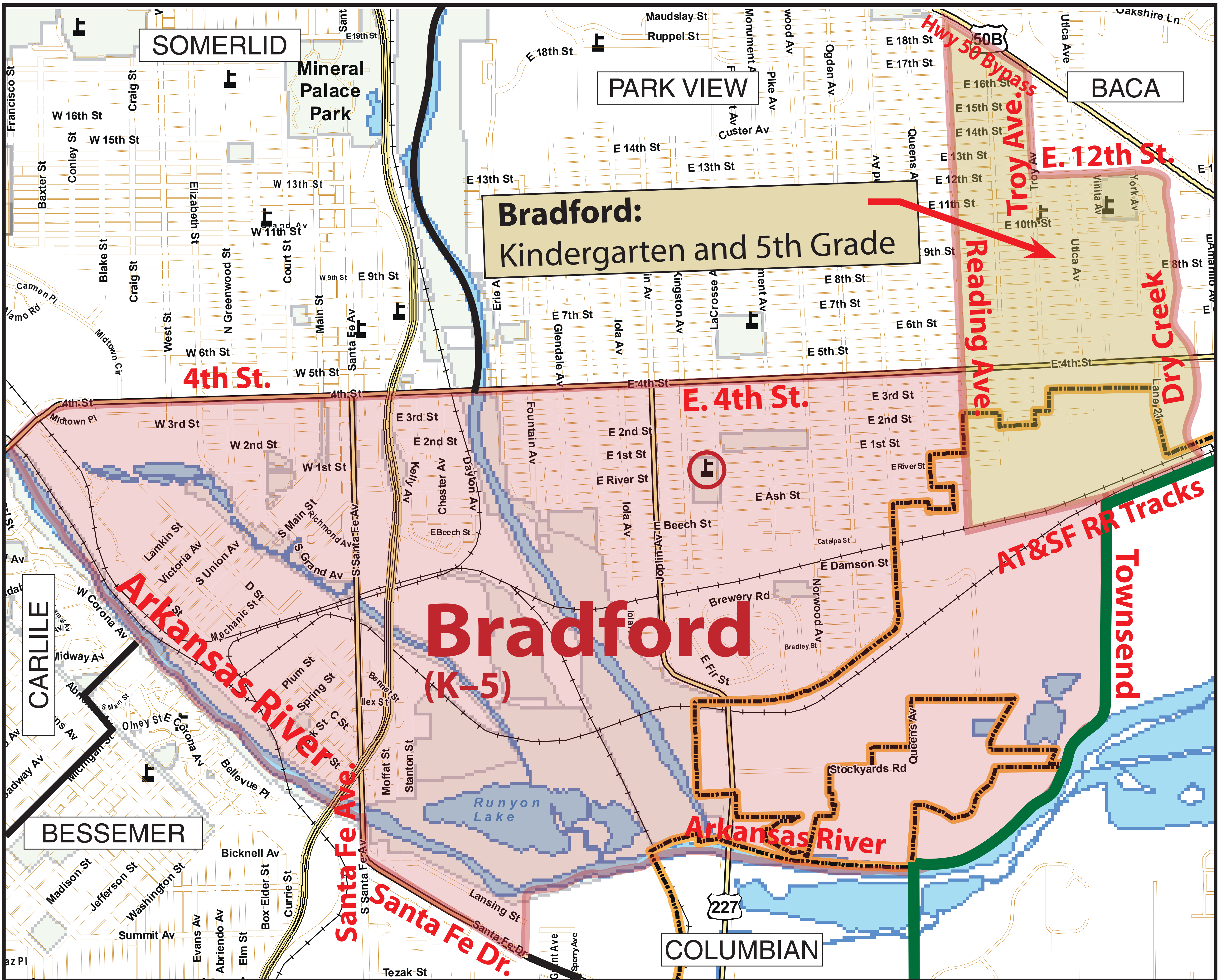

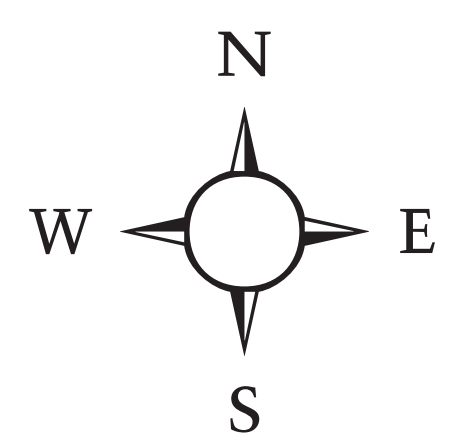
Bradford Elementary School Boundaries

BRADFORD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BOUNDARIES DESCRIPTION

Unless other wise specified, all boundary lines refer to an imaginary line down the middle of the street.

The Arkansas River is the southern boundary at a point where the northern bank and 4th Street intersect. East on 4th Street to Reading Avenue. As 4th Street being dividing line, Bradford boundary being the southern section of 4th Street. At a point of 4th Street and Reading Avenue south to a point that intersects the AT&SF railroad tracks; easterly to Townsend Drive; south on Townsend Drive to a point at the Northern bank of the Arkansas River; westerly from that point to a point that intersects the East 400-500 blocks of Santa Fe Drive; south to Santa Fe Drive; west on Santa Fe Drive to Santa Fe Avenue; north on Santa Fe Avenue to the Arkansas River; northwest along the Arkansas River to 4th Street.

Kindergarten and 5th Grade students within the following boundary attend Bradford: Beginning at the intersection of U.S. Highway 50 Bypass and Reading Avenue; southeast on U.S. Highway 50 Bypass to Troy Avenue; south on Troy Avenue to East 12th Street; east on East 12th Street to the Dry Creek arroyo; south on the Dry Creek arroyo to the AT&SF Railroad tracks; southwest on the AT&SF Railroad tracks to Reading Avenue; north on Reading Avenue to U.S. Highway 50 Bypass.
