

Look out for kids

PLEASE LOOK out for children crossing the street or darting into traffic now that Pueblo's public schools are beginning the new academic year.

All Pueblo City Schools (D60) buildings will be open to welcome students this month. Most D60 schools are scheduled to begin Aug. 29, with the exception of nine schools that opened last week.

The nine schools already in session are Goodnight Elementary, Fountain and Corwin International Magnet Schools and the six schools in the recently established D60 Innovation Zone — Minne-

qua, Irving and Ben Franklin elementary schools; Pueblo Academy of Arts; Roncalli STEM Academy; and Risley International Academy of Innovation.

Motorists, also watch for students at all the Pueblo County District 70 schools. All D70 schools are open, except for K-5 Swallows Academy which opens Thursday.

This is the time of year, with so many students out and about, for motorists to take great care, especially around the little ones.
