Locals get set to meet Macaluso

She is D60's sole finalist candidate for superintendent

Community members as well as school personnel will have two opportunities to meet with Charlotte Macaluso, recently named by the Pueblo City Schools (D60) Board of Education as the sole finalist for the position of superintendent.

Open houses are planned from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. Friday and 7:30 to 9:30 a.m. Tuesday, both at the Administrative Services Center, 315 W. 11th St.

At a Jan. 26 special board meeting, Macaluso, the interim superintendent, was unanimously designated as the sole candidate for the position. This announcement initiated a 14-day waiting period, during which public comment will be accepted.

After this period ends, the board is expected to meet again and formally announce Macaluso as the district's new superintendent.
