Macaluso tabbed to lead D60

14-day period
begins for input

In a special meeting Thursday evening, the board of education of Pueblo City Schools (D60) unanimously selected interim Superintendent Charlotte Macaluso as the sole candidate for the superintendent position.

The announcement begins a 14-day waiting period required by state statute. During that time, a “meet-and-greet” session with Macaluso and the board will allow for public input on Macaluso’s appointment.

After the waiting period, the board is expected to formalize its decision at a special meeting.

Before the vote was taken, Board President Phyllis Sanchez elaborated on the process leading up to Thursday.

“The board has been working closely with the Colorado Association of School Boards in our process of selecting our next superintendent. We’ve also been evaluating Mrs. Macaluso’s performance, which has not only been outstanding but far exceeded our expectations.

“We feel strongly that we already have the very best candidate for the position.”
